

2010 PRESBYTERY ELDER-COMMISSIONER DESIGNATION

The *Book of Order* (G-11.0101a) states that, "When a presbytery meets, each church shall be represented by an elder commissioned by the session," and that churches with memberships over 500 shall be represented as follows:

- 501 to 1,000 members = 2 elder-commissioners
- 1,001 to 1,500 members = 3 elder-commissioners
- 1,501 to 2,000 members = 4 elder-commissioners

In addition, it is presbytery's practice to enroll elders as commissioners when they are elected to Mission Council, as chairs of presbytery standing committees, and as moderator of presbytery. The sessions of churches that have elder members in these positions shall also elect and commission the stated number of elders as provided above.

The following information will be used by the Stated Clerk in preparing the mailing list for commissioners to Presbytery in 2009:
