Ladue Chapel is located at 9450 Clayton Road, St. Louis, MO 63124

Traveling west on I-64 (aka 40):

Take the Clayton Rd. exit. Make right onto Clayton. Follow Clayton to Ladue Chapel. The church will be on your right.

Traveling east on I-64 (aka 40):

Take the Lindbergh south exit. Make right onto Lindbergh. Follow to Clayton Rd. and make left. Follow Clayton to the church. You will cross back under I-64/40. The church will be on your right.
